

ELECTRICAL SAFETY POLICY

The policy is established:

- To comply with statutory requirements and to provide protection to individuals from the risk of damage to their health, equipment and property caused by exposure to electrical works.
- To ensure safe in operation and maintenance of electrical installations at the hospital premises under the supervision of competent persons
- To conduct hazard analysis as to mitigate risk of all occupant and property due to electrical works
- To establish standard operational procedures to ensure the overall integrity of electrical systems, usage and that the equipment are in compliance with guidelines and standards
- To train and improve awareness of stakeholders in practicing and implementing electrical safety at workplace



Electrical safety is a shared responsibility, thus all employees must understand the hazards associated with electric energy and are able to perform the necessary steps to protect themselves and their co-workers. Employees are expected to:

- Read, understand and implement safe work practices for the electrical works carry out at the installation
- Maintain and operate electrical system installation in accordance to HEPPM and statutory requirements
- To wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) provided when working with electrical equipment
- Ensure the tools and testing equipment are in good condition before perform electrical works
- To use Permit to Work (PTW) procedure when required
- Report all injuries and work-related incidents and accidents
- Actively participate in electrical safety improvement activities
